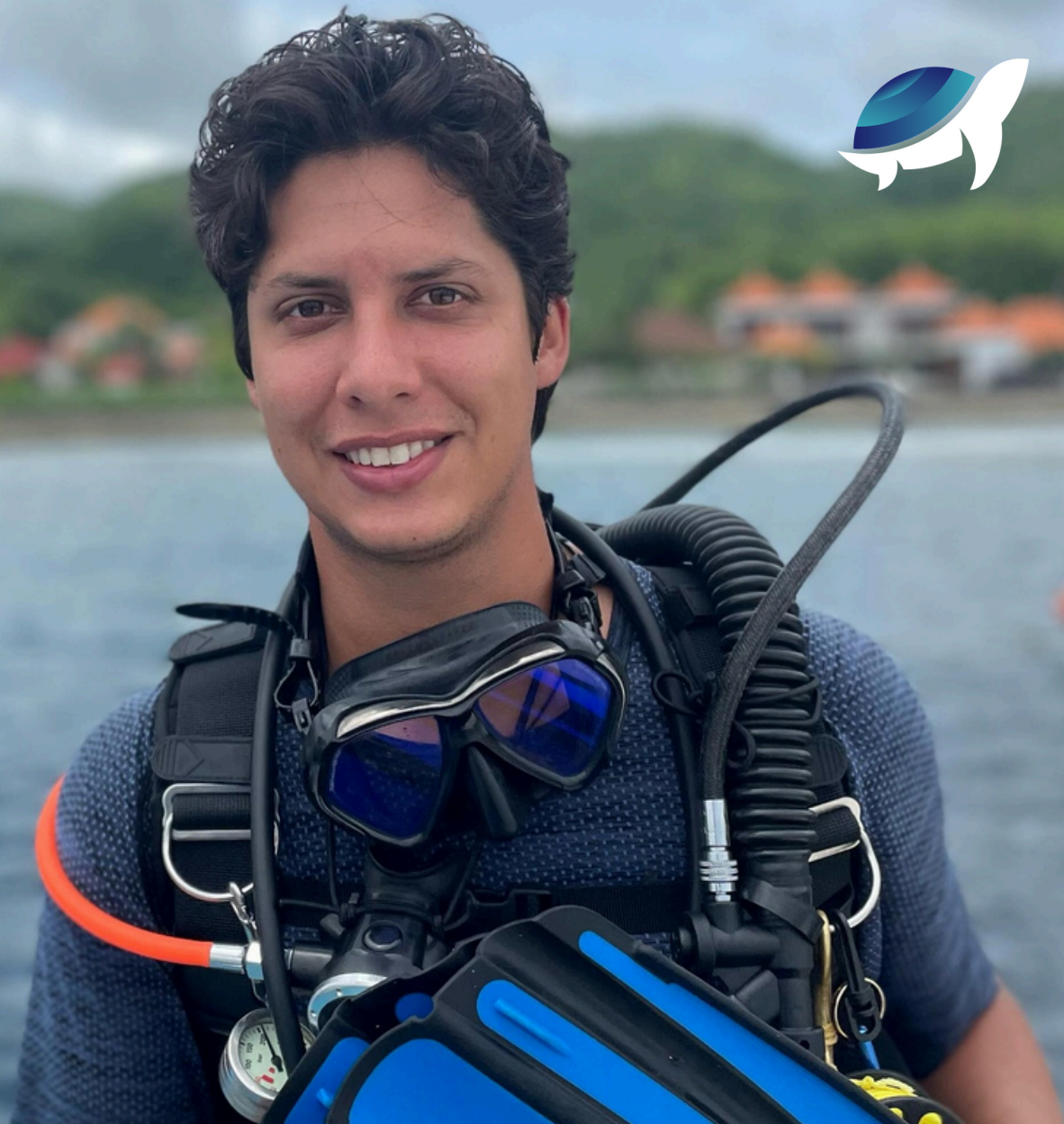




Meet JP
